## **2006 Overview**

### **Monday – Diefinbunker Tour**

Visit one of the most unique tourist attractions in Canada. A huge 4 storey Bunker buried deep beneath the granite hills of Carp, Ontario was built to house crucial elements of the Canadian Government in case of nuclear war, and is now open for you to see. Exhibits and recreated areas give you a startling glimpse into Canada's Cold war history. This tour will also take in a visit to the Hershey Chocolate Factory in Smiths Falls.

### **Tuesday – An Urban Experience**

On the second day of touring we will be visiting the Nation's Capital. After approximately an hour of driving through picturesque countryside, we will arrive in Ottawa and drive along one of the city's many parkways, a scenic route that will take us to our own parking area. From here, your time will be at your leisure. Large capacity shuttle buses will operate throughout the day to deliver you to places of National interest such as the Canada Aviation Museum, the National Gallery, the Parliament Buildings, and the new Canadian War Museum. During your travels you may want to engage in shopping at the Byward market, the Rideau Centre, the Sparks Street Mall or take a boat cruise through the city on the Rideau Canal – a day designed to delight all!

### **Wednesday –Iroquois Village**

We will be making the beautiful drive to the Iroquois Village. In 1956 this village was moved to make room for the 3600 ft. dam, which now lies between Canada and the United States. After learning about one of Canada's first settlements, we will be treated to a fine Roast Beef dinner, we will be visiting CWM Motors in Winchester.
